We Must End AIDS in Children, Adolescents & Mothers in the Next 5 Years

We've achieved great progress

48% decrease in number of new HIV infections among children between 2009 - 2014



900,000 new HIV infections among children stopped by providing access to ARVs for pregnant women living with HIV since 2009



But the fight isn't over

Children



600 children are newly infected with HIV each day

2.6 million children are living with HIV/AIDS



But only 1/3 have access to treatment



50% of children living with HIV die before their second birthday

Adolescents & Young Women



AIDS is leading cause of death for adolescents in Africa



Young women and girls have increased vulnerability to, and risk of, HIV infection



Young women account for 2/3 of new HIV infections among adolescents in Africa



Only 1/4 of adolescents under age of 15 have access to ARVs

16 million

women aged 15 years and older are living with HIV
